Presently Dr. Suzuki is Professor of Microbiology, Professor of Periodontics, Associate Dean for Graduate Education Research and Internal Affairs as well as Director of Graduate Periodontics all at Temple University. He also holds appointments with the National Naval Medical Command, Food and Drug Administration (Chairman Dental Products), Nova Southeastern University, University of Maryland and Maimonides University. In addition to all these activities, Dr. Suzuki maintains a private practice limited to periodontics in Philadelphia.

He represented the interests of CDA on the Implementation Committee of the CSA Model Privacy Code that forms the backbone of the new federal privacy legislation. In addition, Dr. Speers has served as a non-elected member of council at the RCDSO having served on Professional Liability Programme, the Quality Assurance Committee and presently sits as a member of the Complaints Committee.

He is a founding member and President of the International Dental Ethics and Law Society based in Louvain, Belgium. Dr. Speers has delivered numerous presentations on protection of personal health records both nationally and internationally, but will not be talking about that.

It should be no surprise that bad things happen to good people. Anyone in clinical practice will experience bad outcomes, misadventure or simply the reality of being confronted with unhappy patients. 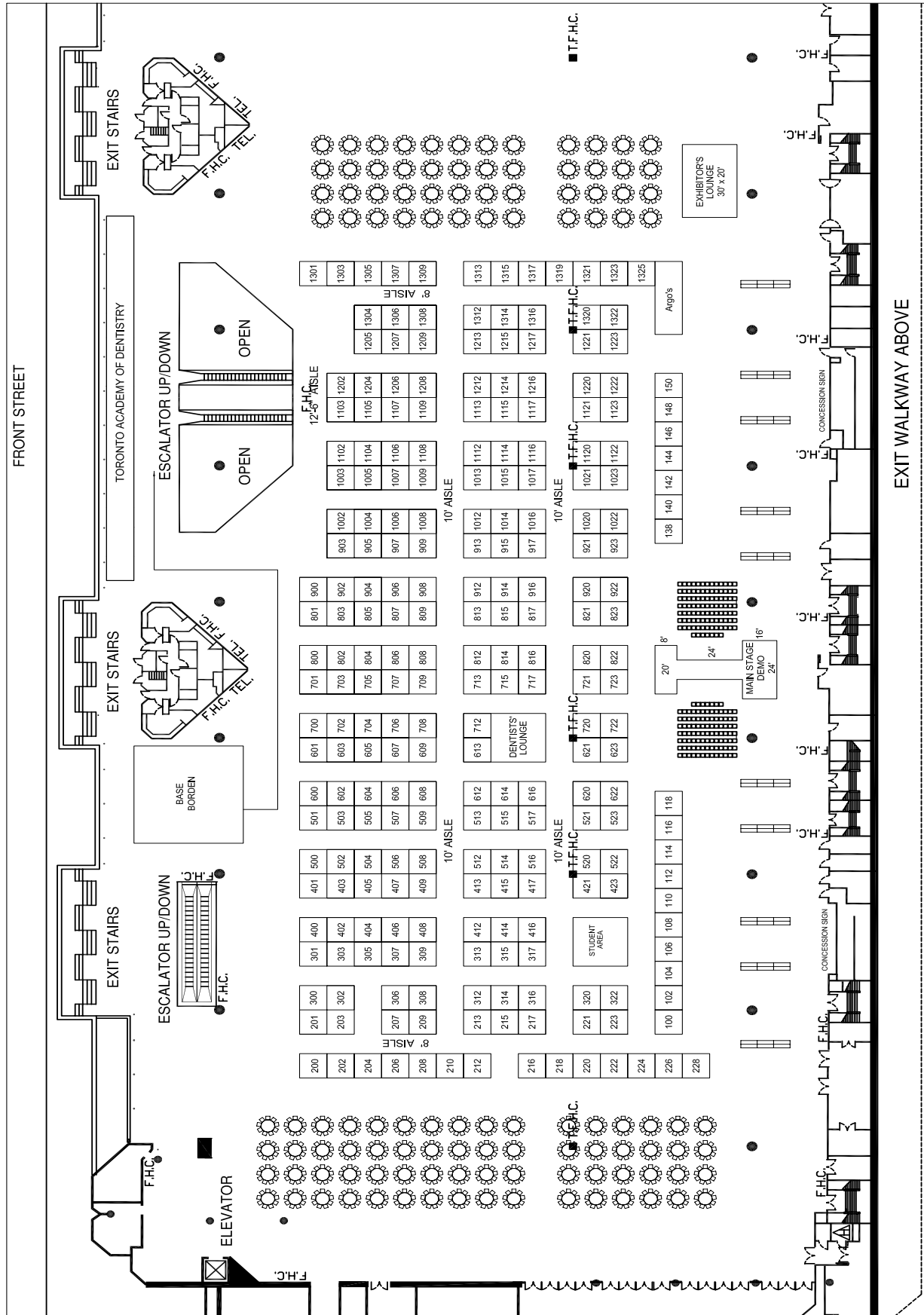

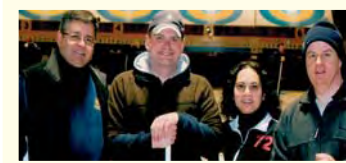

MEDIATIONS REPORT



Gilbert Chapnick, D.D.S.

The Ontario Dental Association has recently updated the Mediations Program in keeping with the changes to the legislation with regards to the privacy and limitations periods.

The Toronto Academy of Dentistry which is comprised of the four Toronto ODA component societies remains in the same capacity as previous. As such it assists in implementing the process, providing telephone and administrative support as well as organizational guidance.

The Mediation process is an important service to both our members and the public as it offers an opportunity to resolve misunderstandings without escalating into formal RCDSO investigations.

This past year has seen a decline in the number of requests from patients for mediations. Dentists who communicate with their patients develop a relationship and rapport which helps to develop trust and satisfaction even when treatment does not go as expected and leads to fewer complaints. Patients want to believe that you are interested in them, so it is important that we allow a few minutes for chatting to demonstrate our true concern for them. If a patient does have a problem with treatment, it must be addressed in a timely manner or it will grow. Give them the opportunity to make their comments while making eye contact and demonstrate that you have heard their concerns with a nod or other neutral response. Ask the patient how they would like the problem resolved and make every effort to maintain a caring relationship.

We are most fortunate in having our volunteer mediations committees. They have resolved many misunderstandings in a fair and equitable manner in keeping with established parameters and they deserve our thanks. As well our Academy staff, Mara Busca-Bedford, and Patricia McCance, have provided us with the assistance we need to communicate with our patients, and help in the detailed administrative requirements that make our programme as effective as it is.

Wesley J. Dunn,

D.D.S., FACD, FRCD(C), (Hon), FADI (Hon), FICD(Hon)



In recognition of his exceptional service to his profession and his community, characterized not only by the breadth and quality of that involvement but also its duration, Dr. Wesley J. Dunn has been chosen as the 2006 recipient of the Toronto Academy of Dentistry's highest award – Honourary Life Membership. In 1947, he graduated from the University of Toronto, Faculty of Dentistry. Dr. Dunn practiced in Toronto from 1947 to 1955. It was in that period that he initiated his interest in the governing aspects of dentistry when he became the organizing secretary for the Canadian Society of Dentistry for Children, 1951- 53. For three years, 1950- 53, he edited Oral Health Magazine. In 1953 he became editor of the Journal of the Canadian Dental Association, serving until 1958.

In 1956, he became the Registrar-Secretary-Treasurer of the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario. It was at that point that his career permanently shifted into the administrative and academic aspects of dentistry. After nine years with the RCDS, Wes was appointed founding Dean of the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Western Ontario, in which position he served until 1982. Coincident with that position, he taught Ethics and Dental Jurisprudence as a Professor at the University of Western Ontario until 1989. In 1989 he became Professor Emeritus.

Over the years Dr. Dunn had a considerable number of articles, papers, reviews, editorials, messages, manuals and books published- approximately 175! He has been presented with numerous prestigious awards and citations. Congratulations to Dr. Wesley Dunn!

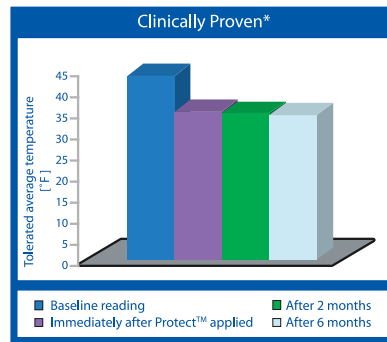

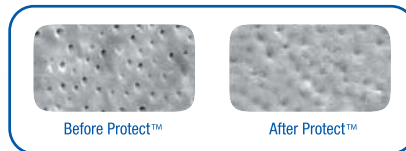
